Morocco economy has set a positive trajectory


The national economic growth is expected to experience moderation in the coming months, driven by the continual expansion of secondary sector activities, including chemical industries, the manufacturing of transportation equipment, and the automotive sector.

Moroccos economy is diverse, with key industries including business services, construction, auto parts, tourism, banking, and furniture. The country's GDP growth rebounded to 7.9% in 2021 after contracting by 6.3% in 2020, and it is projected to reach 3.1% in 2024, and 3.3% in 2025.

IT Services: The IT Services market in Morocco is projected to grow by 7.55% (2024-2028), resulting in a market volume of US\$1092.00 million in 2028.

Business Process Outsourcing (BPO): The BPO market in Morocco is also expected to grow, with a projected growth rate of 4.58% (2024-2028) and a market volume of US\$260.20 million in 2028.

Morocco's construction industry is expected to rebound, with an annual average growth of 3.9% from 2024 to 2027, supported by increased investments in the transportation and energy sectors. The construction market size was \$19.7 billion in 2022 and is projected to achieve an AAGR of more than 3% during 2027 - 2024. The government has announced plans to spend significant amounts on infrastructure and clean energy, presenting opportunities for investment and growth in these areas.



Morocco Mega Projects



Xlinks Morocco-UK Power Project

A new electricity generation facility entirely powered by solar and wind energy combined with a battery storage facility. Located in Morocco's renewable energy rich region of Guelmim Oued Noun, it will be connected exclusively to Great Britain via 3,800km HVDC sub-sea cables. The 20\$ billion Xlinks Morocco-UK renewables project is "on track for completion in 2030". The cable operations will be overseen by XLCC which was set up by Xlinks in 2020. XLCC was granted full planning permission in May to build the UK's first high-voltage direct current (HVDC) subsea cable manufacturing facility in Hunterston, Scotland. Work is due to start in early 2024, with cable production slated for 2026.



Nigeria-Morocco Gas Pipeline (NMGP)

The construction of the mega energy project Nigeria-Morocco Gas Pipeline (NMGP) is scheduled to start in 2024. The pipeline promises to cover the energy needs of over 400 million people in Africa. The NMGP would be 5,600 kilometers long and is set to cross 13 African countries, covering the energy needs of a staggering 400 million people along the West African coast. The project is expected to cost 25\$ billion and would be finished in phases over the course of 25 years.
